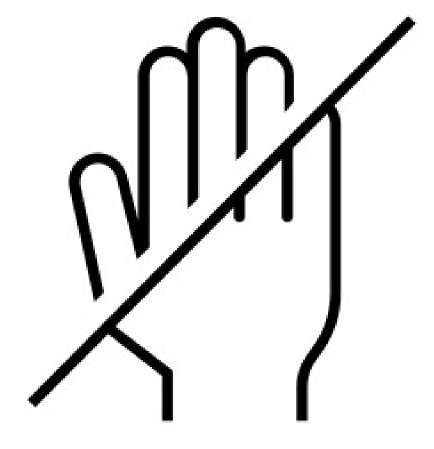

TACTICAL FOULS

Interfering with or Stopping a Promising Attack (SPA)

September 12, 2024





GOALS



- To develop a tactical mind-set to read the game better
- To anticipate when a promising attack is about to happen
- To make the necessary movements to have proximity and a good viewing angle
- To understand how an opponent interferes with or stops a promising attack







CONSIDERATIONS/PRACTICAL GUIDELINES



SPEED (of the player being fouled)

High, medium, or low when the offense occurs?



SPACE

- What is the distance between the offense and the goal?
- How much open, attacking space is there to move into when the offense occurs?

OPPORTUNITY / OPTIONS



- Does the attacking player have control of the ball?
- Can an attacking player gain control of the ball?
- What is the direction of play?
- Where are the attackers and defenders (location of defenders) when the offense occurs?
- How many options does the attacker have at the time of the offense?

READING THE GAME



READ THE PLAY

- Which team has possession of the ball and how did they gain possession of the ball?
- Scan the field the first time.
- How is play developing/building up?
- Identify the players involved, colors and numbers.



YOU ARE THE REFEREE, THINK:

- How do I adjust my position and viewing angle?
- Players' actions/options.
- Speed of play.





READING THE GAME



ANTICIPATE

- The next phase of play.
- What might the players do next, attackers/defenders?
- Scan the field a second time just before you anticipate a foul and ask yourself: where are the other players?

YOU CALLED THE FOUL

- Take a snapshot of the location of players (attackers/defenders), space.
- What were you anticipating would happen next?
- What could the player and the other players have done if play had continued?



- What are the clear considerations that you observed during the incident?
- Based on that, make your decision.





- Teamwork



Explanation

Direction, speed, location and number of defenders

Practical Concepts

Good positioning, correct reading, anticipation, and quick reaction



Good positioning, correct reading, anticipation, and quick reaction





 The defender trips the opponent stopping a promising attack; caution for #3 in the team in Yellow












SUMMARY
